Re- employed Ex-Servicemen (ESM) in CPSEs - Reg.

1. With due respect, All India Forum of Ex-Servicemen in PSEs (AIFEPSEs) humbly brings the following facts to your notice for kind consideration and favourable action towards welfare of retired Soldiers.
2. Your august office is aware that Soldiers of Armed Forces renders selfless service to the motherland by sacrificing self and family interests and get compulsorily retired at unusual middle age of 32 to 42 years to keep Armed Forces youthful. Hence, welfare of ESM has been utmost importance of the Government as it has a direct impact on morale of the serving Soldiers in view of their early retirement from active service when their financial and domestic responsibilities are at peak.
3. It's a known fact that the sacrifices and severity of service conditions borne by the soldiers and indirectly by their families while serving the motherland at different terrains of India cannot be compared for/compensated by any other means. The veteran soldiers had been away from their families due to necessity while in service. Their domestic requirements are at peak and having

responsibility towards higher education of children, daughter's marriage, care of aged parents etc. at their 40s. Having been away from the family and undergone through highly tough life while in Armed Forces, they find themselves alone amid being away again from their home/family after re-employment in civil side. There are many institutions like central Govt. Departments, CPSE banks etc. are considering these difficulties of veteran soldiers and providing postings on their re-employment at such locations, where they can serve left over service with their families.

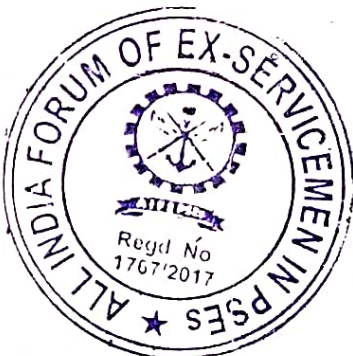
4. A common problem being faced by many Ex-Servicemen re-employed in CPSEs is the posting at other than home zone area. This Forum understands the uphill task of management to utilise its human resources efficiently as per terms of employment, however a guideline on preference for the posting of re-employed veterans may be in place so that concerned management can consider the same on humanitarian ground.

As the Department of Public Enterprises is the Nodal Agency for all CPSEs and formulates policies / guidelines on personnel management pertaining to them, it is worthwhile that DPE may please formulate/institute a suitable guidelines over the issue considering self-sacrificing services of veterans Soldiers to the Nation for compliance by respective administrative Departments/concerned CPSEs.
